

SCFC - RETURN TO FOOTBALL – MANAGER / COACH GUIDANCE



Everyone needs to comply with the requirements of the FA & Club Covid 19 guidance. This is important as it will ensure that we all remain safe. There can be no short cuts or 'not bothering' to comply. Covid 19 is still present in the community and we cannot assume that none of us have it, therefore, we all must take the required actions to keep everyone safe.

BEFORE FOOTBALL ACTIVITY

READ THE FA GUIDANCE AND CLUB COVID 19 DOCUMENTS INCLUDING CLUB RISK ASSESSMENT PLAN FOR YOUR TRAINING/MATCH SESSION TO COMPLY WITH ALL REGULATIONS

MAKE SURE YOUR PLAYERS & PARENTS KNOW WHAT THEY NEED TO DO AND HOW TO DO IT

ENSURE PARENTS KNOW THEY MUST COMPLETE A PARENT CONSENT FORM.

NO CONSENT = NO EVENT

UNDERTAKE A SELF HEALTH CHECK FOR YOURSELF BEFORE LEAVING HOME

CLEAN ALL EQUIPMENT YOU PLAN TO USE BEFORE THE SESSION/MATCH

BEFORE THE SESSION STARTS BRIEF ALL YOUR PLAYERS & PARENTS & EXPLAIN THE ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE SESSION/MATCH

PUT UP A RESPECT LINE
LAY OUT CONES, 1M APART, SO THAT SPECTATORS CAN WATCH AND MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCE

CREATE AND RETAIN AN ATTENDANCE REGISTER

CALL OPPONENTS

WHEN PLAYING HOME MATCHES, CALL AND SPEAK TO THE OPPOSITION. ASK THEM TO COMPLY WITH THESE GUIDELINES, DISCUSS ANY SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS FOR THE GAME.

DURING ACTIVITY

NO PRE-MATCH HUDDLES

ARRANGE HYGIENE / DRINKS BREAKS REGULARLY

2 SANITISED MATCH BALLS TO BE USED IN GAMES

WIPE 1 BALL WHEN NOT IN PLAY

ASK PARENTS TO SANITISE GOAL POSTS AND FLAGS AT HALF TIME

SOCIAL DISTANCE AT HALF TIME

THE COACH IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ENSURING COMPLIANCE TO COVID CONTROLS

FOLLOW SCFC FIRST AID GUIDANCE

AFTER ACTIVITY

ENSURE ALL PLAYERS RETURN TO THEIR PARENTS
REMIND THEM OF THE WAY OUT

CLEAN ALL USED EQUIPMENT

WASH YOUR HANDS WHEN ABLE TO DO SO
